The "Munich Model" program

Within the framework of the Munich Model, the City of Munich offers locals on moderate incomes and families the chance to rent apartments at attractive rates. Rents for the apartments offered as part of this program range from EUR 7.50 to EUR 11.00 per square meter. Potential applications must have had their principal residence or worked in Munich for at least three years. For families with children, this period is reduced to only one year. The City of Munich subsidizes the property developers who build these apartments and sells the land at a discount rate.

Recognition of foreign qualifications

Candidates for certain professions must possess school and vocational qualifications that are accepted as equivalent to their German counterparts. The most important requirement for recognition of vocational qualifications is an adequate command of the German language (to level B1 at least). Professional associations, chambers and ministries will be happy to walk you through the often complicated process of having foreign school and vocational qualifications recognized in Germany. The most important advisory services are listed below:
